Donors can make donations through separate companies that are not subsidiaries. *See* Ethics Board Opinions 2014-097 (donations can be made in both individual capacity and in capacity as majority owner of an LLC) and 2006-476 (individual can make donations both in personal capacity and in capacity of LLC in which individual was 50% owner). Thus, these donations do not exceed the per-person donation limits set forth in La. R.S. 18:1505.2.

Although Parish rules require disclosing any donations made by co-owners, each of the donations are within the per-person limit. *See* Ethics Board Opinions 2014-097 (individual could make maximum donations in both his personal capacity and in his capacity as majority owner of an LLC) and 2006-476 (where individual owned 50% of an LLC, he could make donations in both his personal capacity and in the LLC's capacity without those donations being aggregated).
