CONSENT AGENDA TWO

RESOLUTIONS AND MOTIONS BY COUNCILMEMBERS

1. Resolution - requesting and authorizing the Planning Department and the Planning Advisory Board to study the text of Ch 11; Ch 33; Ch. 40 of the Code, with the intent of clarifying regulations for group homes, assisted living facilities, and board and care homes; creating definitions, standards, and regulations for homeless shelters, emergency shelters, assisted living facilities, transitional housing, board and care homes, clinics, institutions, permanent supportive housing, campuses, and other related uses; establishing interim development standards during the study. (Parishwide) (Placed on the agenda by Mr. Templet)
2. Resolution - requesting and authorizing the Planning Department and the Planning Advisory Board to study the zoning and future land use of certain properties along Airline Drive, generally bounded by Airline Drive, Severn Avenue, Johnson Street, Causeway Boulevard, and North Labarre Road, as shown on a map titled “CPZ on Airline Drive Area Study” dated May 23, 2023; with the intent of rezoning the area from the existing zoning to the most appropriate zoning; establishing interim development standards during the study; and providing for related matters. (Council District 5) (Placed on the agenda by Ms. Van Vrancken)

3. Resolution - authorizing the Parish of Jefferson to enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement with the State of Louisiana to remove debris resulting from Hurricane Ida from certain State claimed water bodies and lands along Bayou Barataria in the Parish of Jefferson where such debris represents an immediate threat to life, public health and safety, and/or the economic recovery of the community at large; and authorizing the Jefferson Parish Department of Drainage to provide services for the removal of debris resulting from Hurricane Ida from certain State claimed water bodies and lands along Bayou Barataria in the Parish of Jefferson. (Council District 1) (Placed on the agenda by Mr. Edwards)
4. Resolution - requesting the State of Louisiana through the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Parish of Jefferson to fund the 10% local cost share to Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funds associated with the removal of debris from certain State claimed water bodies and lands along Bayou Barataria and adjacent to the Town of Grand Isle in Jefferson Parish resulting from Hurricane Ida where such debris represents an immediate threat to life, public health and safety, and/or the economic recovery of the community at large. (Council District 1) (Placed on the agenda by Mr. Edwards)
5. Resolution - authorizing the Jefferson Parish Department of Drainage to survey the State claimed water bodies adjacent to the Town of Grand Isle to identify extent and location of debris resulting from Hurricane Ida where such debris represents an immediate threat to life, public health, safety, and the economic recovery of the community at large. (Council District 1) (Placed on the agenda by Mr. Edwards)
