Once he announced his candidacy and began participating in the election cycle for the At-Large position, he was eligible to receive donations up to \$5,000 per donor. Therefore, these donations are within the limits set forth in La. R.S. 18:1505.2. *See also* La. R.S. 18:1483(3)(a).

¹¹ This amount is comprised of donations from Pivotal Engineering and its two co-owners. Although Parish rules require Pivotal to disclose any donations made by its co-owners because they own more than 25% of Pivotal, each of their donations are within the per-person limit. *See* Ethics Board Opinions 2014-097 (individual could make maximum donations in both his personal capacity and in his capacity as majority owner of an LLC) and 2006-476 (where individual owned 50% of an LLC, he could make donations in both his personal capacity and in the LLC's capacity without those donations being aggregated). Councilwoman Van Vrancken received \$900 from Pivotal Engineering and \$2,250 total from Pivotal's principals, each of which are within the donation limit \$2,500 per donor per election cycle for district-level Councilmembers.
