Although Parish rules require Pivotal to disclose any donations made by its co-owners because they own more than 25% of Pivotal, each of their donations are within the per-person limit. *See* Ethics Board Opinions 2014-097 (individual could make maximum donations in both his personal capacity and in his capacity as majority owner of an LLC) and 2006-476 (where individual owned 50% of an LLC, he could make donations in both his personal capacity and in the LLC's capacity without those donations being aggregated). Councilwoman Van Vrancken received \$400 from Pivotal Engineering and \$2,250 total from Pivotal's principals, each of which are within the donation limit \$2,500 per donor per election cycle for district-level Councilmembers.
