

Coastal Erosion and Salt Water Intrusion

Louisiana beaches and coasts are shrinking. This process is called "coastal erosion". When the beaches and coasts shrink, more sea water moves in, and that water is SALTY! This is called "salt water intrusion".



Some water animals live in salty water, others live in fresh water, and some can survive in both.




CLUES

6. The color of tree bark + a yummy crustacean with long antennas.





Help the rainwater find the storm drain.




Did you know ...
