On motion of **Ms. Van Vrancken**, seconded by **Mr. Walker**, the following resolution was offered:

RESOLUTION NO. 143458

A resolution extending the interim development standards in Section 2 of Council Resolution No. 141261, adopted February 8, 2023, which established standards for single-, two-, three-, and four-family dwellings located in the unincorporated areas of the Parish of Jefferson, on the unprotected side of the West Bank and Vicinity Hurricane Protection Levee, for a period of six (6) additional months or until the effective date of final Council action, whichever comes first. (Parishwide)

WHEREAS, to promote the public health, safety, and welfare, the interim development standards should be extended for a six (6) month period or until the effective date of final Council action, whichever comes first, so that requirements are in place that support the intent of the study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jefferson Parish Council of Jefferson Parish, Louisiana, acting as governing authority of said Parish:

SECTION 1. That the interim development standards in Section 2 of Council Resolution No. 141261, adopted February 8, 2023, which established standards for single, two-, three-, and four-family dwellings located in the unincorporated areas of the Parish of Jefferson, on the unprotected side of the West Bank and Vicinity Hurricane Protection Levee, be and are hereby extended for an additional six (6) month period or until such time as the study is completed or cancelled.

SECTION 2. The extension of interim development standards is in accordance with and by the authority of Sec. 33-2.21.5 of the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, providing, in pertinent part, that when the Jefferson Parish Council initiates a study to prepare an amendment to the text or official maps of Chapter 33, Chapter, 40, or the Comprehensive Plan, and pending final disposition of the study, the Jefferson Parish Council may establish interim development standards that provide for reasonable approval conditions for certain types of development applications that would otherwise be affected by the study for one (1) year, which may be extended by the Jefferson Parish Council for not longer than one (1) six (6)-month period.
